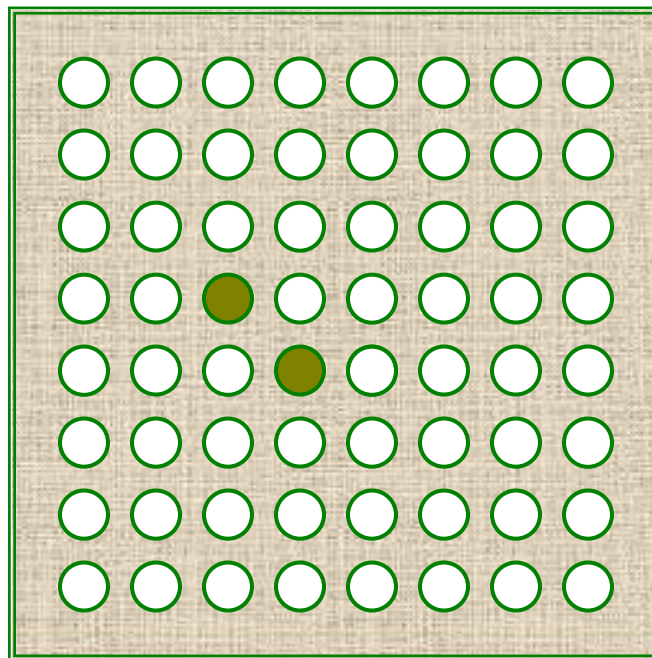




## Straight shot

Directions: Get a pencil. The goal is to journey from one darkened dot to the other darkened dot. If you just went ahead and connected the two dots with a single line, congratulations ("You are good!!!") but we had something a little more rigorous in mind. Can you achieve the same goal while following these rules? You must carry out your journey without lifting your pencil. You must go through all the others dots in your journey between the "start" darkened dot and the "finish" darkened dot. Your journey must involve 14 continuous, straight lines. You must be on a dot when you change direction. You can go through the same dot more than once if you wish but please remember to keep your pencil on the page (or computer screen) as you go. Select your "start" darkened dot and get going. Good luck...
